Welcome to the Dhimurru Short Stay Facility. We hope you have an enjoyable and productive time whilst visiting the Miwatj (sunrise) country of the Yolngu. We have put together some information to assist you whilst using our facility and some pointers for getting out and about.

CHECK OUT

Check-out time is 10:00am on the day of departure. If you require a late departure please contact Dhimurru on (08) 8939 2700.

Keys are to be returned to the Dhimurru office or left in the room key safe or locked in the room (if office closed).

FACILITIES

AIR CONDITIONERS:

Individual Air Conditioners are operated using the remote control found in each room. Please turn off airconditioner when vacating the premises.

Please ensure that ceiling fans in all rooms are left on (at least on low setting) at all times. This is to ensure that air is circulating and to prevent the onset of mould. Please close all windows before vacating the premises for any length of time.

TORCHES:

In the case of a power outage there is a torch located in the set of drawers in your room. Please remember to return the torch to the same location once finished using.

TV:

Local available TV channels include Imparja, Channel 7 (Cairns), SBS and ABC.

To operate the television turn tv and antenna on at power outlet, and turn on at television. Use the controls on the television to operate. Also refer to antenna operation manual under the Manuals section of this package.

KITCHEN FACILITIES:

Kitchen facilities include a fridge, double electric hot plate, microwave and toaster.

To operate the hot plate plug into power outlet and turn on. Turn dials to heat corresponding plates to desired temperature. Ensure power supply is turned off at dials and power outlet when not in use.

A full set of cooking utensils is provided as well as eight piece crockery, cutlery and glassware sets.

To turn off outside lights at night please find switch in kitchen.

LOCAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

LIQUOR PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

An Alcohol Permit is required in order to buy, possess and drink takeaway alcohol within the East Arnhem Region, including the township of Nhulunbuy. Permit applications can be lodged at the Department of Justice, Shop 6 Endeavour Square, Nhulunbuy. To obtain a permit you will require a letter of residency/accommodation details from Dhimurru and photo identification. Please note that office hours are Monday to Friday from 08.00am to 4.30pm. DHIMURRU ACCESS PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Dhimurru implements and manages an access permit system which enables people to have access to popular Designated Recreational Areas on Aboriginal land, whilst ensuring that landowners requirements are met. Dhimurru has been delegated authority to issue these permits from the Northern Land Council pursuant to the *Northern Territory Aboriginal Land Act 1979*.

Guests wishing to visit a Dhimurru *Designated Recreation Area* (for recreational purposes) must obtain a *General Permit* before accessing the area. Guests may also need to obtain a *Special Permit* (dependent on which *Recreation Area* is to be accessed).

Special Permit areas are subject to additional requirements aimed at minimising recreational impacts, maintaining access for Yolngu, and providing exclusive opportunities for visitors (i.e. those areas where only one group is allowed at a time). Bookings for Special Permit areas are required. A General Permit is a prerequisite to obtaining a Special Permit.

NLC (NORTHERN LAND COUNCIL)

Arnhem Land consists of nearly 100,000 sq km of Aboriginal owned land. The Yolngu people (Aboriginal people of the region) have inalienable freehold title over this land, currently with the exception of the mining lease that the town of Nhulunbuy is located on. The title to this land is held by The Aboriginal Land Trust. Permission to enter onto Aboriginal Land outside of the mining lease MUST be obtained from the Northern Land Council. If you plan to drive to Nhulunbuy from the Stuart Highway, you must access an NLC permit, otherwise you are not covered by any insurance in case of an accident. SWIMMING

Saltwater crocodiles inhabit all natural waterways in the Northern Territory. You can swim safely at the Nhulunbuy Olympic sized public swimming pool located adjacent to Nhulunbuy Corporation, Endeavour Square.
