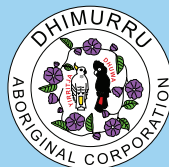

Access is governed by YolŲu Traditional Owners through Dhimurru Aboriginal Corporation. Access without a valid Dhimurru On Country Pass is not authorised.

DAY USE AREAS

DHIMURRU ON COUNTRY PASS

All visitors must hold a valid Dhimurru On Country Pass to enter the Dhimurru Indigenous Protected Area. A valid Camping Permit is also required to camp.

CAMPING AREAS

CAMPING PERMIT

To visit or camp in the following areas you must have a valid Dhimurru On Country Pass and an Exclusive Camping Permit even for day use.

Exclusive camping areas

- ✓ WANUWUY (CAPE ARNHEM)
- ✓ GAPURU (MEMORIAL PARK)
- ✓ GANAMI (WONGA CREEK)
- ✓ LURRPUKURRU (OYSTER BEACH)

EXCLUSIVE CAMPING PERMIT PRICES*

Adult	\$30 per person / per night
Teen (13 to 18 yrs)	\$15 per person / per night

Check in:	2pm day of reservation
Check out:	12pm day of check-out

SPECIAL ACCESS PRICES*

Business Permit

Applies to FIFO employees working on Dhimurru-managed land (FIFO Employees) \$55 per person / per year

Special Access Permits

Traditional Owner Approval Required

Media / Research / VIP Access from \$250
Prices are dependent on scope and duration

Commercial Tour Operator Permit

Base fee	\$1,250
More than 40 tours/year	additional \$750

MAXIMUM VEHICLE CLEARANCE

Height	2.5m
Width	2.1m
Weight	3.5 tonne

Low impact camper trailers are acceptable at designated campsites in the Dhimurru Recreation Areas. Please see the Visitors Guide for more information.

They should be as follows:

- ✓ Single axle
- ✓ No internal toilet/shower or waste management system
- ✓ Can be towed with standard, single rear axle 4WD Vehicle

There is a park at the Walkabout Lodge and Manyimi Campgrounds.

We encourage you to book well ahead of time.

STAY SAFE



Avoid strenuous walks in hot weather; **inform someone of your route and travel time. Carry plenty of water**, wear suitable clothing and sturdy footwear.



Bury toilet waste 2 ft deep, 100m from campsites, water, and trails
Take rubbish with you; dispose of waste properly.



Water is not provided in DAC recreation areas; **bring enough for your stay.**



Boats and boat trailers **only permitted at Daliwuy Bay.**



No hunting or firearms including bow allowed on Yolŋu land. No **unregistered** motorbikes or ATVs (quads).



BE CROC WISE

Estuarine Saltwater Crocodiles (bäru) are present in all waterways – avoid swimming and be cautious near all bodies of water.



Do not dispose of fish carcasses near campsites or boat ramps.



LOOK AFTER YOURSELF AND OTHERS



Be cautious of all wildlife and **seek medical attention if bitten/stung**. Avoid mosquitos and sandflies – use repellent, wear protective clothing, and choose campsites wisely



BUFFALOS ARE DANGEROUS

Avoid close contact, especially at dawn or dusk.



WATCH OUT FOR STINGERS

Jellyfish are common (Oct-May); treat stings with vinegar and seek medical help.
